The Evidence Of Biochemistry

Darwin said, "If it could be demonstrated that any complex organ existed which could not possibly have been formed by numerous, successive, slight modifications, my theory would absolutely break down." Biochemist Michael Behe has demonstrated this through "irreducibly complex" molecular machines. These complicated, microscopic contraptions are extremely unlikely to have developed through Darwinian processes.

The Evidence Of Biological Information

The six feet of DNA coiled inside every one of our body's one hundred trillion cells contains a four letter chemical alphabet that spells out precise assembly instructions for all the proteins from which our bodies are made. This kind of complex, independent pattern or function always implies an intelligent source.

Moreland defined consciousness as our introspection, sensations, thoughts, emotions, etc. that make us alive and aware.
