

## **"All Flesh Is Grass"**

Peter, in 1 Peter 1:24-25, "*For, All flesh is as grass, And all the glory thereof as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower falleth: But the word of the Lord abideth for ever. And this is the word of good tidings which was preached unto you.*" Since the word abides forever, we need to be reminded of three important points concerning the word of God.

First, the word is powerful. Hebrews 4:12 says, "*For the word of God is living, and active, and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing even to the dividing of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and quick to discern the thoughts and intents of the heart.*" The word possesses power because of what it can do. It can change the sinner to a saint! Second, the word will judge. John 12:48 says, "*He that rejecteth me, and receiveth not my sayings, hath one that judgeth him: the word that I spake, the same shall judge him in the last day.*" The word is not to be toyed with or disrespected, for it will determine our eternal destiny based on whether we obey it or not. Third, the word will save. Romans 1:16-17 says, "*For I am not ashamed of the gospel: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.*" It will save because all of us sin and the Bible reveals how Christ died on the cross, redeeming us from the bondage of sin.
