- C. He resisted sin (Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:22).
- D. He chose disciples (Matthew 10; John 13-16).
- E. He taught truth and made promises (John 1:17; 8:32; Matthew 16:13-18).
- F. He died, arose and was exalted (1 Corinthians 15:1-8; Ephesians 1:20-23).

## III. ***What Does He Mean To Me?***

- A. He is my Savior (Titus 1:4).
- B. He is my King (Colossians 1:13).
- C. He is my Advocate (1 John 2:1-2).
- D. He is my access to God (Hebrews 4:14-16).
- E. He is my daily companion (Matthew 18:20; 28:20; 2 John 9).

## IV. ***Will I Tell Others About Him?***

- A. He wants us to evangelize (Matthew 28:18-20).
- B. We know we should (James 4:17).
- C. The disciples ceased not to preach and teach (Acts 5:42).
- D. We know the terror of the Lord (2 Corinthians 5:11).
- E. He is coming again (2 Timothy 4:1; 1 John 3:1-3)!
