Introduction. These sermons have been about character, and character is important (Proverbs 22:1; Ecclesiastes 7:1). So to build character, we learn from people who are godly and become the men we need to be. God has given us a leadership position that is a serious responsibility.

I. Enoch

- A. Hebrews 11:5.
- B. Men who possess acceptance (2 Corinthians 5:9; Colossians 1:9-10).

II. Noah

- A. 2 Peter 2:5.
- B. Men who possess righteousness (Matthew 21:32; Titus 1:1-3).

III. Solomon

- A. 1 Kings 3:5-14.
- B. Men who possess wisdom (Psalm 119:27, 34; James 3:13-18).

IV. Joseph

- A. Genesis 39:7-12.
- B. Men who possess virtue and purity (1 Timothy 1:5; Revelation 14:1-4).

V. Nehemiah

- A. Nehemiah 2:17-18.
- B. Men who possess vision and determination (Ephesians 6:10; Colossians 4:7-12).

Conclusion. The true definition of manhood is not how many women someone has been with, or how many fish he has caught or deer he has killed. It is how close his character is to God's ideal (Romans 8:29).
